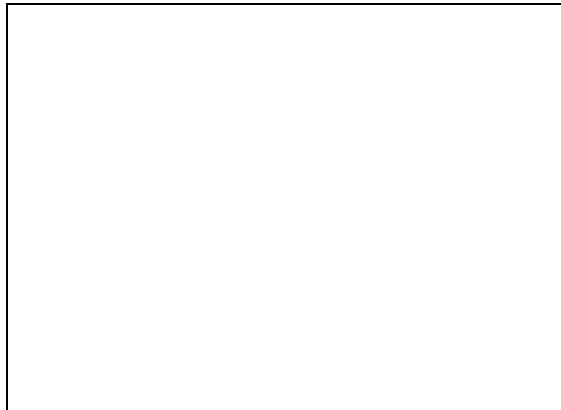

World Gourmet Summit to honour regional culinary talents

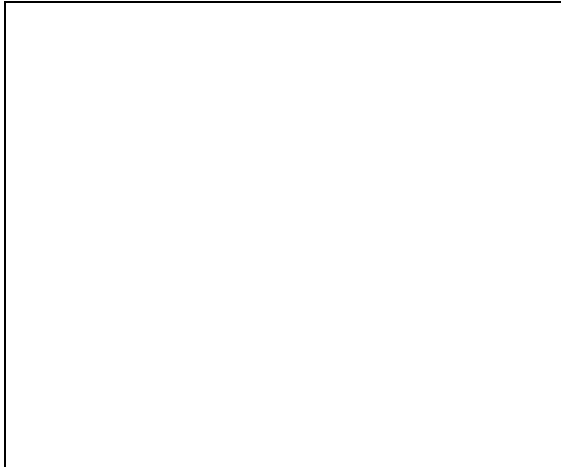
